

Pilot Out-of-Town Student Program [OSP] Resolution

Upon the request of the Staff of YGW, the Board of Directors of the institution has approved a pilot Out-of-Town Student Program (OSP) governed by the policies and procedures presented to the Board at the December 11, 2014 Board meeting.

The pilot program will have the following additional stipulations:

1. It will be a two year pilot program only.
2. There will be a committee of the Board that will oversee the program and meet regularly with the staff leadership of the school.
 - a. The Headmaster will present the Board with an implementation plan including a comprehensive communication plan.
 - b. The Headmaster will ensure regular reports (no less than quarterly) are prepared by the staff and provided to the full Board with key performance measures of the OSP.
3. The RGB will serve as a third party oversight of the program and will monitor all incident reports in order to be aware of egregious or persistent issues, with the full authority to intervene at any time.
4. The Headmaster will provide a year-end report at each June Board Meeting that will:
 - a. Analyze the positives and negatives from the OSP for the school year
 - b. Provide year end statistics
 - c. Make recommendations on any changes to improve the program

At the end of the two years the OSP will end unless the Board has voted to continue the program.
