There are three components to our English curriculum. We have assigned texts that are used within each of our classes, as well as assigned summer readings. Each of these texts are continually assessed and monitored by the hanhala for appropriateness.

In addition, in all English classes, our students are required to write book reports on four outside readings (approximately one per quarter). We feel that it is important for parents to be involved in all aspects of their child's education. Although we have a Yeshiva Reading List from which students are encouraged to choose books for their book reports, we still request parent involvement in the decision of which books they deem appropriate for their particular child.

Please fill out the form at the bottom of this letter, and return it to your child's English teacher. Thank you for your cooperation with this important component of your child's education.
